I. POLICY

- A. Lamar UniversitýLU) determineshe eligibility of University employees to drive or operate vehiclesin the University's vehicle fleet. Only Universitynctioned drivers are allowed to operate fleet vehicles. Unscreened LU employees or those who do not melenthersity's driver selection criteria may not operate a University fleet vehicle
- B. To drive or operate a University fleet vehicle, an employee (a) must have a Drivided's Licenseor the ability to obtain one within 90 days of hire; the iver's Licenseous also be of the appropriate class to operate the vehicle; and (b) must have a satisfactory driving, record as stated in this and other University plicies

II. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- A. This policy falls under the authority of the Texas State University (STSUS) Rules and Regulations, Chapters IV and VII; the Texas State Vehicle Fleet Management Plan administered by the State of Texas' Office of Vehicle Fleet Management (Other Mexas Government Code, Chapter 58, 2171, and 2175; the Texas Transptoth Code, Chapter 521; and all other applicable federal, state, and TSUS laws, statutes, rules, and regulations.
- B. To establisheligibility to drive or operate a University fleet vehicle, LU follows Section 521.459 of the Texas Transportation Code, what he texas Transportation Code, which he tex
 - (1) Before employing a person as a driver of a motor vehicle used to transport persons orproperty, an employer shall request from the Department [PublicSafet]:
 - a. a list of convictions for traffic violations contained in the department records on the potential employeand
 - b. a verification that the person has a license.
 - (2) A personmay not employ a person as an operator of a motor vehicle used to transport persons or property who does not hold the appropriate Driver's License to operate the vehicle as provided by this chapter [Chapter 521Texas Transportation Code]
